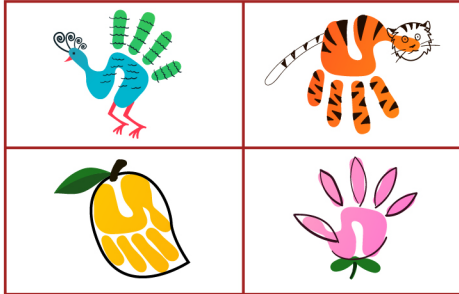

Imprint India!

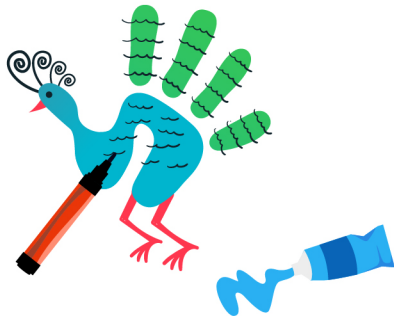
Use your palms and create India's national symbols.

Things you need:

- White Paper
- Paints
- Paintbrush
- Felt Pens
- Pencil

Steps to follow:

Divide the paper into four equal rectangles.

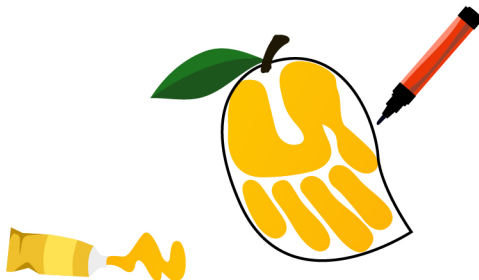


Peacock

1. Paint your palm royal blue and imprint it straight in one of the rectangles.
2. See the reference photo and make the peacock's crown, beak, and legs using felt pens.

Tiger

1. Paint your palm orange and imprint it upside down in the second rectangle.
2. Draw the tiger's stripes, face, and tail using felt pens.



Mango

1. In the next rectangle, paint your palm yellow and imprint it upside down.
2. Draw the border, stem, and leaf of the mango.

Lotus

1. Paint your palm pink and imprint it straight in the fourth rectangle.
2. Draw the stem and leaves of the lotus.

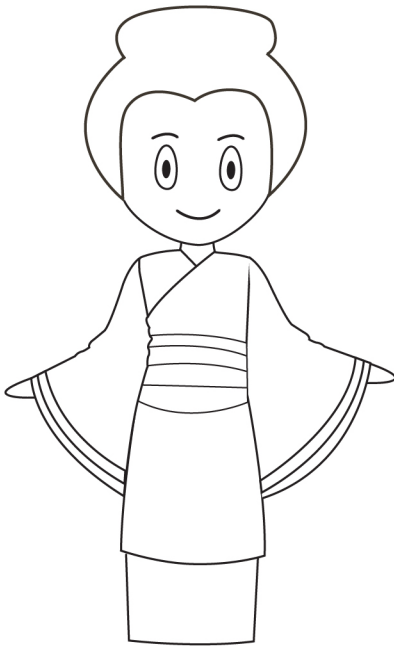

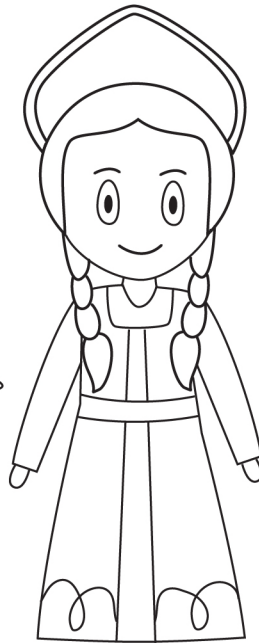

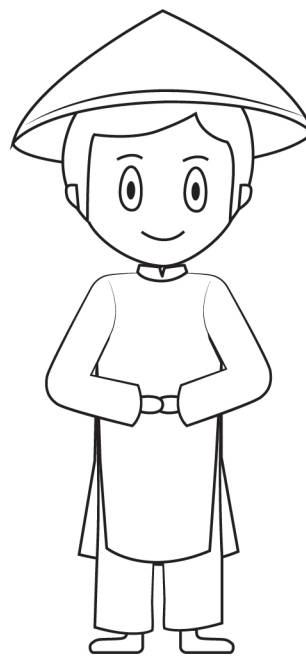

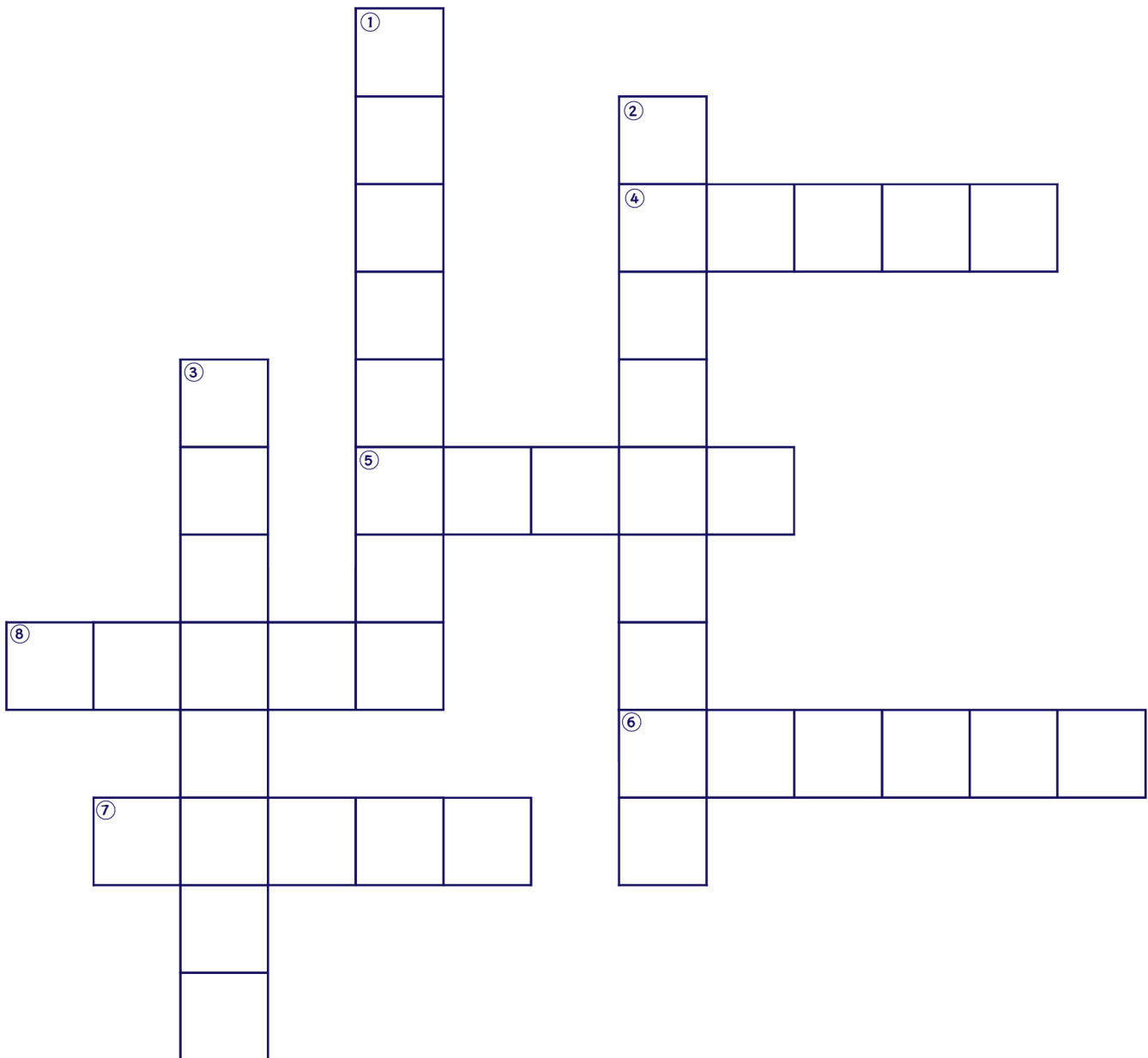
