Let's hop and jump like the Australian kangaroos!


#### Things you need:

- A sheet of thick paper
- Scissors
- Crayons or paints
- Glue
- Stapler


#### Steps to follow:

- 1. Colour the Kangaroo's face as you wish on the printable provided below.
- 2. Cut the face around the edges.
- 3. Cut a narrow rectangular band as per the size of the head from paper.
- 4. Stick the Kangaroo's face onto the band and secure the end with a stapler.
- 5. Wear it around your head. Hop, jump, and have loads of fun!

- Scissors


### Steps to follow:






1. Make two halves of an A4 sized sheet of white paper.














5. Draw the sheep's face on black paper and stick the googly eyes and the mouth on it.
