After reading the book, let's discuss the story together and see how much of the book you remember!


- What is chocolate made out of?

Chocolate Play Dough

Chocolate is called 'Food of the Gods' for good reason! Smell it, feel it, and watch the brown gooey richness of chocolate through this playful sensory activity.

*Adult assistance required for this activity.

Things you need:

- 2 cups of flour
- 3 tablespoons of oil
- 1-1/2 cups of boiling water
- 1/2 teaspoon of vanilla essence
- 1/2 cup cocoa
- 1/2 cup of salt
- Large bowl Whisk

Steps to follow:




1. Mix all the dry ingredients into a large bowl.





3. Now slowly add the boiling water and keep whisking until a ball starts to form.








Choco-Chip Counting
