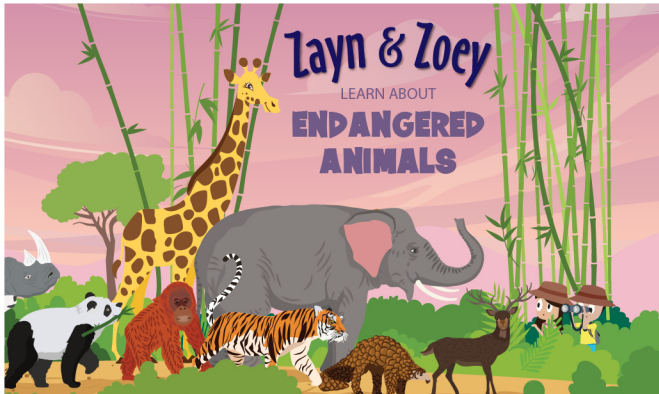


Zayn & Zoey

Here are some fun activities related to endangered animals to do with children.



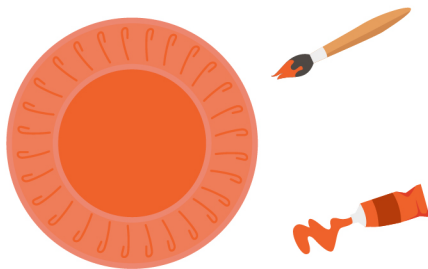
Tiger, Tiger

Let's paint, cut, and paste to make a mask of the Royal Bengal Tiger, and go ROARRR!

Things you need:

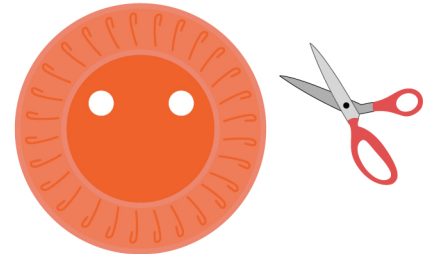
- White paper plate
- Orange paint
- Paint brush
- Ice cream stick
- Scissors
- Black marker
- Glue
- Sticky Tape
- Craft sheets – black, orange

Steps to follow:



1. Flip the paper plate and paint back side of it orange.

2. With help of an adult, trace and cut out two holes for the tiger's eyes.



3. Cut two triangles from the orange craft sheet for the ears and cut eight long triangles from the black paper for the stripes and stick them.



4. Stick a small one for the nose and draw the mouth with black marker.



5. Secure the ice cream stick at the back of the paper plate with tape.

Hold the mask against your face and 'ROARRR'!

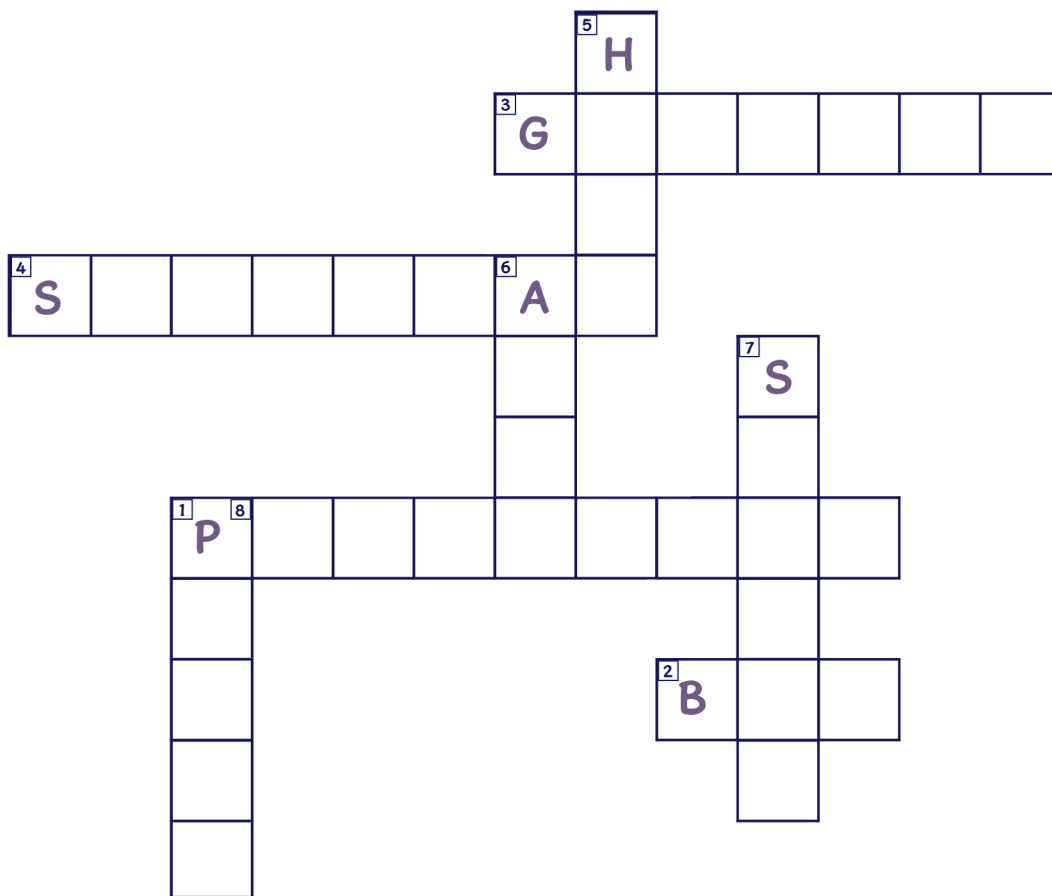
