### Things you need:

- Ice cream stick
- Red and black felt pens
- Small black pom pom
- Black marker
- Small googly eyes
- Glue

### Steps to follow:



1. Colour the stick with black and red for trousers and tunic. Leave space for the belt and face as shown here.

2. Stick the black pom pom on top for the bearskin hat.



3. Glue the googly eyes and draw expressions with the black marker.

4. Use your craft as a bookmark. Write a little note at the back and gift it to your loved ones!
