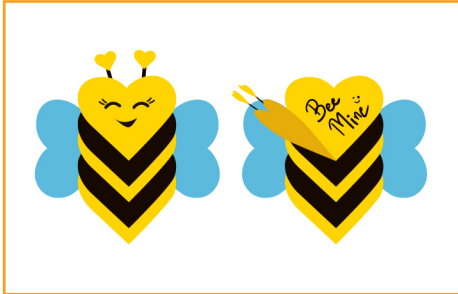

Bee of Hearts

Let's make a cute honey bee out of hearts.
You can also use it to send messages!

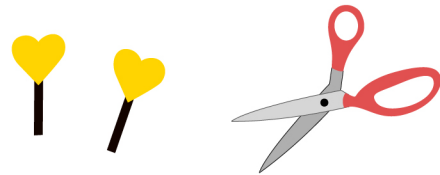
Things you need:

- Craft paper – yellow, blue, and black
- Black marker
- Glue
- Scissors

Steps to follow:



1. Cut two yellow hearts connected to each other. Cut two yellow, two black, and two blue single hearts.

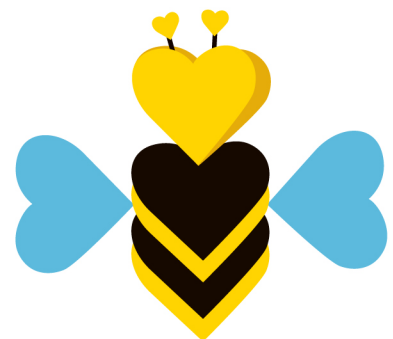


2. Cut two small yellow hearts and two strips out of black paper to make antennae.



3. Fold the connected yellow hearts. This will be the head of the bee.

4. Make the body by sticking black and yellow single hearts one below another behind the head. Stick blue hearts as wings and the antennae at the back of the head.



5. Make a cute face with the black marker. Flip open the top piece to write a message to your loved ones!

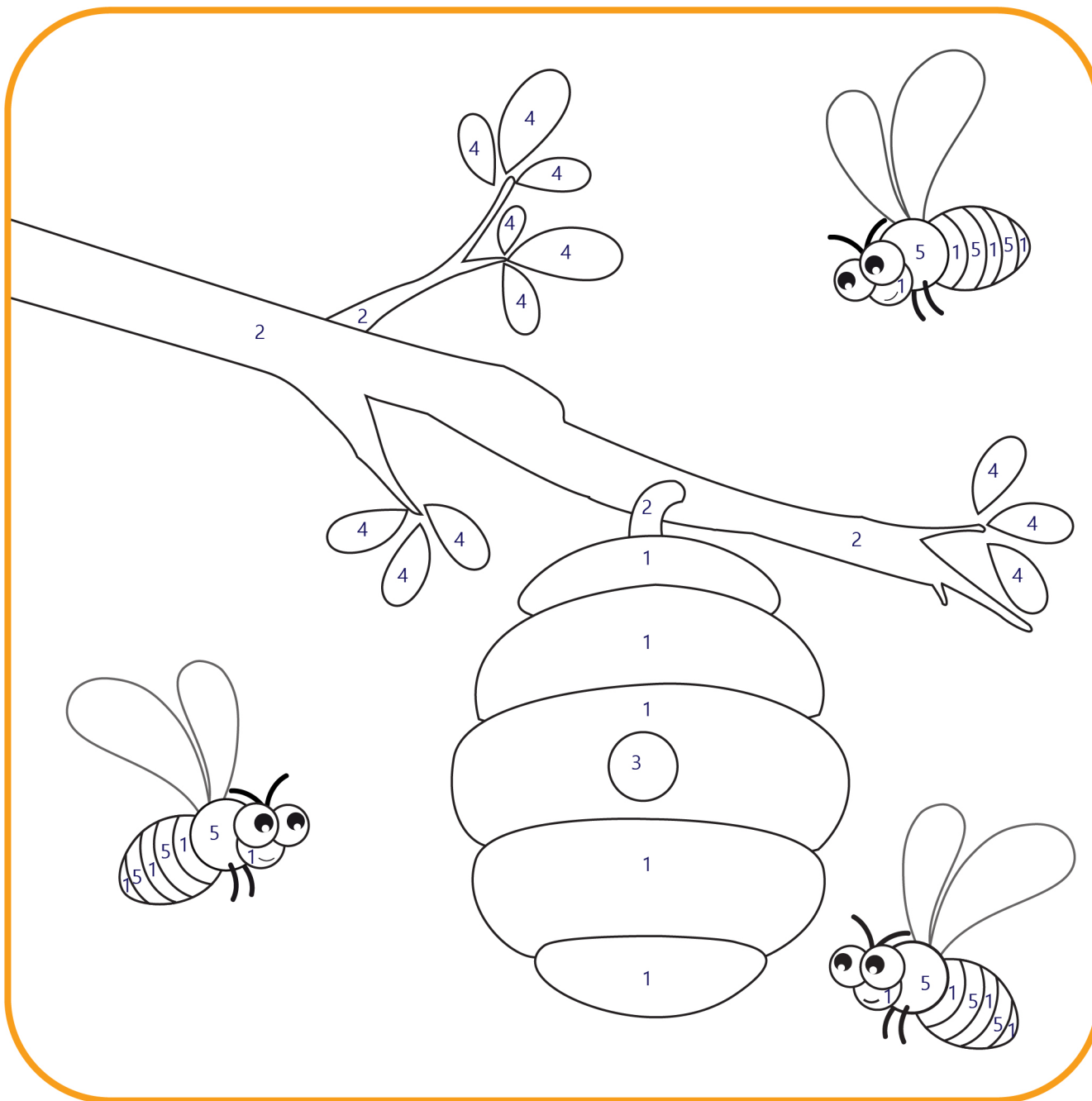
