

HANDS ON FUN!

Here are some fun activities related to the life cycle of a ladybug to do with children.



Paper Roll Ladybug

Ladybugs are so colourful, aren't they? Let's make a cute and easy craft using common household items.

Things you need:

- Empty paper roll
- Paints
- Craft paper red, black

- Paint brush
- Black marker
- Scissors

- Glue
- Googly eyes

Steps to follow:



1. Paint the paper roll black.

2. Stick two antennae made from black paper from inside the paper roll, letting them stick out. Stick googly eyes.








3. Cut a circle out of the red paper and make two equal halves.

4. Make black spots on the red semicircles with the marker to make wings.



5. Stick the wings onto the body, just below the eyes.

6. Your ladybug is ready!






Ladybug Colour Board
