Here are some fun activities related to Reduce-Reuse-Recycle to do with children.



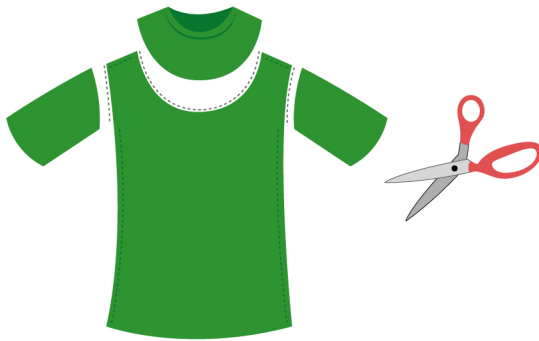
T-Shirt Tote Bag

Are not ready to part with your favourite t-shirt? Convert your worn-down t-shirt into a creative tote bag that you can reuse!

Things you need:

- Old t-shirt
- Scissors
- Fabric paints or markers

Steps to follow:



1. Cut out the sleeves and neckline. Turn the t-shirt inside out.



2. Determine the length of the bag. Cut fringes from the bottom of the t-shirt up to the desired length.



3. Knot the tassels of both sides. Make tight double knots.



4. Turn your t-shirt right side out again and decorate it with paints and markers.

Voila, your eco-friendly reused bag is ready!

It's Our Responsibility

Let us celebrate Mother Earth by conserving her!

Imprint your hand and pledge to keep the planet clean and green through this craft activity.

Things you need:

- Blue craft sheet
- Green paint
- Marker
- Paint brush
- Scissors

Steps to follow:

1. Trace a circle on blue paper using a plate and cut it out.
2. Paint your palm green and press it on the centre of the circle.
3. Paint a few sections green around the handprint using the paintbrush.
4. Once dry, write 'I will Reduce Reuse and Recycle' at the centre of the palm.



Pin it around your work area and implement the 3Rs as much as possible!

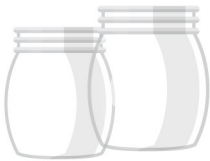
