Blow Art

Let's make an erupting volcano using the blow painting method.

Things you need:

- White art sheet
- Water
- Brown colour paper
- Paint colours (red, yellow, orange)
- Scissors

Straw


Glue

Steps to follow:



1. Cut brown paper into the shape of a volcano mountain and stick it on a white art sheet.

2. Dilute the paints and put drops of watery paint above the mouth (crater) of the mountain.



Your erupting volcano is ready!



3. Now, with the straw, blow the paint in upward direction to show an erupting volcano.

Lava Maze


The lava is bubbling hot. Solve the maze to create a path for the lava to come out of the crater.






Volcano Match


Identify the type of volcano and match the picture with its correct name.
