
HOUSES AROUND THE WORLD with ZOCY

Tent at the Campsite


Camping in a tent is so much fun! Let's make one with paper and create wonderful photo memories!

Things you need:

- One black or grey craft sheet One bright coloured craft sheet A photograph of yourself

• Scissors • Glue

Steps to follow:



2. Gently, lift the corner of the silts and fold them towards the sides of the tent to create the tent entryway.



4. Stick your photograph in the centre.



Your tent is ready!

1. Cut a big triangle from the bright coloured craft sheet. Slit the base in the centre to make an opening in the tent.



3. Stick the tent on the black craft sheet, leaving the entryway open.



5. Create your own surroundings for your campsite!

House of Shapes


If you look at a house, you will notice that it is made with so many shapes! Let's take some simple shapes and make a lovely house for ourselves!

Things you need:


- Craft sheets in assorted colours Scissors Glue

Steps to follow:

Use the different coloured craft sheets to cut:



1. Rectangular strips, about 6 inches long.



2. Two squares for windows.



3. A rectangle for the door and another for the chimney.



4. A large triangle for the roof.

Place the shapes on a base sheet and play around with them to create a unique house of your imagination. Glue them onto the sheet when you're ready.
